

## Some Events for Canfield Dorwin and family from church registers

### Register of Anglican Church, Louiseville, Quebec

Canfield Dorwin, merchant of Montreal, married Olivia Mary Cushing spinster of Rivière de Loup on July 27, 1831 by Mr. Burwell the missionary for Rivière de Loup and hence the probable location of the marriage. The bride and groom signed as did J. H. Dorwin and J. Grant, stepfather and M. Grant.

### Christ Church, Montreal

Emelia Isabella Dorwin daughter of Canfield Dorwin of Montreal, merchant and Olivia Mary Cushing was born 16 February and baptized 11 May 1837. Sponsors signed: Jedediah H. Dorwin, Isabella Dorwin and Caroline M. Lord.

Mary Ann Chipman Dorwin daughter of Canfield Dorwin of Montreal, exchange broker and Olivia Mary Cushing was born 20 August 1839 and baptized 23 June 1840. Sponsors: (signatures are unclear and could be other than what I have transcribed) were T. Cushing and E. L Cushing and a third which is illegible

### St. Stephen's Anglican Church, Montreal

Charlotte Louisa Dorwin daughter of Canfield and Olivia Mary Cushing was born 1 October 1843 and baptized 9 February 1844. Sponsors: William Parker as proxy for Daniel Trallom, Emmeline Potts, Sophia A. Dame

Amalia Isabella daughter of Canfield Dorwin of the city of Montreal died 14 April and was buried 16 April 1854, witnessed by William Wilson.

Ruth Caroline Dorwin daughter of Romeo Dorwin of New Haven, Vermont and of Ruth Davids his wife was born 20 April 1849 and baptized 1 January 1864. Sponsors: C. Dorwin, Olivia Dorwin

*One suspects that Romeo Dorwin must have been a brother or nephew of Canfield and Jedediah Dorwin.*

### American Presbyterian Church, Montreal

Mary Ann Chipman Dorwin, aged 3 years and 3 months, daughter of Canfield Dorwin of Montreal, exchange broker. Died 31 October and buried 3 November 1842. Witnesses: C. Dorwin and J. H. Dorwin

Harriet Sophia Dorwin, aged 15 months, daughter of Canfield Dorwin of Montreal, exchange broker. Died 23 November and buried 26 November 1842. Witnesses: C. Dorwin and J. H. Dorwin
