

EVELEIGH FAMILY ADDITIONAL CENSUS DATA

1852 Census: Saint-François-d'Assise-de-la-Longue-Pointe LAC Microfilm C1129, p. 25
Robert Eveleigh and wife N. [sic Ann or Nancy] Robinson resided on an 80 acre farm of the First Range in this parish. On the same range, on a 75 acre farm, was his brother-in-law James Robinson, wife Anne Galbraith and their son, James.

Nearby lived P. Raynolds [sic] and his wife E. Galbreigh [sic] on 114 acres. Patrick Reynolds (farmer of Montreal) had married Elizabeth Galbraith at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, in Montreal, on May 3, 1830 and may be the man responsible for attracting Robert Eveleigh and James Robinson back to Montreal, assuming that his wife was a sister of Ann Galbraith Robinson.
