

1825 Population Return for the Township of Rawdon, County of Leinster, Quebec, Canada

LAC Microfilm C718, pages 1503 – 1507

This census was recorded 25 October 1825 and was transcribed by Marian E. Aelick (formerly at m.aelick@sympatico.ca) on 24 June 1999. It was revised by Daniel Parkinson in November 2001 (and subsequently, using evidence from other original documents) with correct spelling of names and the identification of names misspelled by the enumerator. Some settlers, known to be at Rawdon 1820 – 1825, were not enumerated on this census. Comments are by Daniel Parkinson & Marian Aelick.

Marian believed that her ancestor ELIAS AELICK, whose name is spelled with the following variations ALEX - ALLICK - EALICK - ELLICK - EHLIG - ELIG – ELIGH, was born at Rawdon, Quebec in 1821 I have found no evidence of people with these names in any documents relating to Rawdon, Quebec.
